Tony Shram is cursed. He just lost his 28th straight bet on a football game, the worst betting streak any gambler in Philly can remember. He's ruined a perfectly decent career as a con artist by racking up an \$80 thousand gambling debt. His bookie has given him four weeks to come up with the cash. The clock is ticking.

Meanwhile, Shram's neighbor Izzy has just discovered that her boss at the nursing home where she works has been embezzling from his patients. With the help of her crooked (and desperate) neighbor Shram, she comes up with a plan to steal money back from the home. If the plan works Izzy can improve the care for the home's residents, finance her dream to move to Costa Rica, and pay Shram's debt in one fell swoop. If not she'll end up in jail, and Shram, who she's amazed to find she's starting to fall for, could end up dead.

A comedy about gamblers, con artists and cheats -- both inside and outside of the health care industry -- Sucker Shram is about getting the help you need from where you'd least expect it.
